



Ravena Coeymans Historical Society 2017 Scholarship

Criteria

- **Eligibility:** Grade 12 students residing in the Town of Coeymans
- **Essay:** In an original essay of approximately 500-1000 words, describe a person (living or dead) who has made a significant contribution to the Town of Coeymans by including (a) details of his or her life (e.g., birthplace, parents, school(s), occupation), (b) nature of the contribution and (c) impact or implication of the contribution on the town.
- **Format:** The essay should be typed (using 12 font) or printed and double spaced. It is to include the application form (student's name, school, home address, telephone, email, signature), a list of primary and/or secondary sources, and photographs (optional).
- **Deadline:** May 1, 2017
- **Award:** \$250
